Skin cancer exposed

In the UK, 37 people are diagnosed with melanoma every day. When treated early it can usually be cured, but the disease still claims tens of thousands of lives every year throughout the world. According to the World Health Organisation, skin cancer accounts for one in every three cancers diagnosed worldwide, with global incidence on the rise. In the UK one in every 10 skin cancers are diagnosed in the "late" stage, and it can take weeks for patients to see a dermatologist.

Early detection through pro active screening will help to greatly reduce late stage melanoma.

Skin Cancer is a "recreational cancer" caused by too much sun. Sunburn can double the risk of skin cancer. Lots of sun over your lifetime also increases your risk of certain skin cancers. There are now more deaths from skin cancer in the UK than in Australia.

With rates set to treble in the next 30 years, it's never been more important to protect our skin from the sun's harmful Ultraviolet (UV) rays.

Melanoma

The most dangerous skin cancer has increased 43% in 10 years (Source: Cancer Research UK). Anyone can get melanoma. The risk usually goes up with age. People with light-coloured hair, eyes and skin have a higher risk than people with darker colouring.

People with a family history of melanoma also have a higher risk. With melanoma it's essential that it is detected early. If you have any concerns about a mole, we recommend you speak to your GP as soon as possible.

1 in 3 people will develop cancer in their lifetime. Early detection through screening is a potential lifesaver and a valuable employee benefit.

When cancer is diagnosed at an early stage, treatment is often more likely to be effective resulting in faster and less expensive treatment. This may be instrumental in reducing future costs of private medical insurance, income protection insurance and life assurance for employees.

Private health insurance / cash plans

Private Health insurance and in particular CASH PLANS can allow up to 100% of the total cost of annual screening to be claimed back. In many cases, this is one of the most underused allowances in a policy, often because of the cost. Cancer screening can cost less than £100 per person, so you could have no out-of-pocket expense at all. You might be able to get the full cost of the screens up to £200 reimbursed.

Cash-back plans are an underused and underutilised benefit. For very little money per week it is possible to get help with, for example, dental bills or new glasses. An increasing number of cash back plans offer reimbursement on 'screening services' and for some of these plans Screen4Life services may get covered. Skin cancer screenings

£110 per person or £1,930 for a full corporate day*

This normally takes about 25 minutes with one of our experienced dermatology nurses. She will check your body using a dermatoscope initially, and where appropriate she will use specialist non invasive digital imaging technology called SIAscopy which enables her to see 2mm below the surface of the mole or lesion. The results are immediate and an output of the SIAscopic scan can be produced in to a personalised report for suspicious lesions.

If there is nothing suspicious this will be confirmed at the time of screening, however, depending on the personal risk factors there may be recommendation to have moles scanned periodically.

If something appears to warrant further attention your report will be forwarded to our doctor and specialist for review. Depending on his assessment, you will be advised if any further action is necessary. If required, we will forward your scan results to your GP and/or referral to a specialist.

A simple urine sample test with immediate results given to the employee at the appointment.

Prostate cancer screening
